President: JR started the meeting by letting the board members know that this meetings focus was on setting the budget for 2017 calendar year.

Membership: Bob Obregon let the board know that the membership is now at 167 members. Bob shared an updated membership form with the board and a suggested renewal form for current members. The board is going to work on updated versions over the next few months.

The majority of the meeting was spent reviewing the 2016 budget and actual expenses and then making recommendations for the 2017 budget. For 2016 the expenses exceeded the budget. With a lot of consideration the board was able to determine where the budget deficiencies were and made some changes to account for those areas when preparing the 2017 budget. At this time there will not be a dues increase for the 2017 flying year.


